



Advent Paper Chain

Gather five different colors of construction paper (e.g. white, yellow, green, red, blue). If your printer can print on 9 x 12-inch construction paper, print each of the following pages on a different color. If not, instead make marks 1 3/4 inches apart down both sides of the short side of the paper. Cut out the strips so you have five 1 3/4 x 12-inch strips of each color. Then, in alternating colors, hand write the below information on the construction paper strips (e.g. day 1 on white, day 2 on green, day 3 on red, day 4 on yellow, day 5 on blue, etc.)

Keep the strips in the back of your Bible, and each day of advent, pull out the appropriate strip for the day, read the Scripture and use the discussion question. Then add each new day's strip to the paper chain by using glue or a stapler (curling so the writing is on the inside). Use it as a decoration throughout Advent, and enjoy watching it grow!
