The Colorado State Capitol is one of the key battlegrounds for your family's freedoms, which is why much of our labor centers around influencing lawmakers and legislation at this strategic location. This past year alone, HB25-1312 created a storm of controversy and public outcry because of its serious potential impact on parental rights.
